

2014-2015 ENROLLMENT Information for RETURNING Families

Application Fee

\$100.00 per family due with admissions application. All application fees are non-refundable. The application (i.e. "re-enrollment") fee will be waived for returning families who submit their re-enrollment forms by March 1.

Tuition

Pre-Kindergarten \$4130 (5 days/week) \$2200 (2 days/week)
Kindergarten \$4130 (5 days/week) \$3000 (3 days/week)

1st-6th Grade \$6014 7th-12th Grade \$6845

A multi-student discount of \$162.50 per child will deducted from the tuition beginning with the second child. Applicable legacy discounts will be deducted on the enrollment contract. (Discounts will be applied only to students enrolled at Veritas during the 2012-2013 school year or before. 2014-2015 is the last year the multi-student and legacy discounts will be offered.)

Tuition Assistance

Veritas Academy offers need-based financial assistance to families on a first-come, first-served basis as funds are available. Levels of tuition assistance offered will depend on a number of factors including total (gross) family income, number of family members, and the number of children enrolled at Veritas. If you are applying for financial assistance to help with tuition expenses, you must complete a FACTS application online (see www.veritassavannah.org/financial-aid) and submit all required documentation to FACTS BEFORE MARCH 1. It is expected that families will pursue every other available means of financial assistance (family, other scholarship funds, etc.) prior to applying for aid directly from Veritas.

Enrollment Deposit

Families whose children have been accepted to Veritas will receive an enrollment contract that must be signed and returned to the school. This signed enrollment contract must be accompanied by an enrollment deposit totaling one-twelfth (1/12) of the family's total tuition obligation. Payment of the enrollment deposit will guarantee your child's placement in the classroom.

Payment Plans

The remaining tuition balance after payment of the one-twelfth deposit may be paid using one of the following payment plans:

1-Pay Plan: One (1) lump sum payment due on June 1. There is no discount for this early lump sum payment.

12-Pay Plan: Twelve (12) equal payments due on or before the first day of each month beginning with June 1, with the final payment due on or before May 1. If the one-twelfth enrollment deposit payment is paid prior to May 1, eleven monthly payments will begin July 1 and continue through May 1.

Payments on the 12-Pay Plan must be made through FACTS and will incur a one-time processing fee from FACTS. You must set up automatic bank payments from your checking or savings account at least two weeks before your first payment is due. For instructions see www.veritassavannah.org/courses-and-tuition.

RETURNING FAMILIES Timeline:

January 1 Formal enrollment season begins. Applications may be submitted earlier, if desired.

January-March Enrollment Assessment Testing for new applicants (new siblings of returning students). The school will notify applicants when they are to be tested.

March 1 If returning families sign and submit the re-enrollment form by March 1, the \$100 re-enrollment (application) fee is waived. If the re-enrollment (application) form is submitted *after* March 1, families must pay the re-enrollment (application) fee of \$100.

March 1 If you are applying for financial assistance to help with tuition expenses, you must complete a financial aid application (online at www.factstuitionaid.com) and submit all required documentation to FACTS by March 1 in order to receive priority consideration for assistance.

Applications for admission WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE ABOVE DATES and will be considered as the school has openings.

Applications for financial assistance WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE ABOVE DATES and will be considered as the school has available funds.

March 10 Enrollment contracts and acceptance letters will be issued by March 10. Notifications of financial assistance will be included in the contracts.

March 25 Enrollment contracts and deposits must be returned to the school. Returning families who do not submit their contract by this date will not be given priority in filling available spaces or priority in financial aid awards. Veritas will guarantee classroom placement and financial aid awards only if the contract and deposit are received by March 25.

One-twelfth (1/12) of the total tuition due must be paid as a deposit with signed contract. Families who are currently making monthly payments may sign their contract and request a deferral on the one-twelfth deposit until May 1.

AFTER March 25 applications for admission and financial aid for returning and new families will be processed and considered as they are submitted and as the school has openings and as financial aid funds are available.
