**LOST & FOUND:** The box in the office is OVERFLOWING! Please stop by to see what you might be missing.

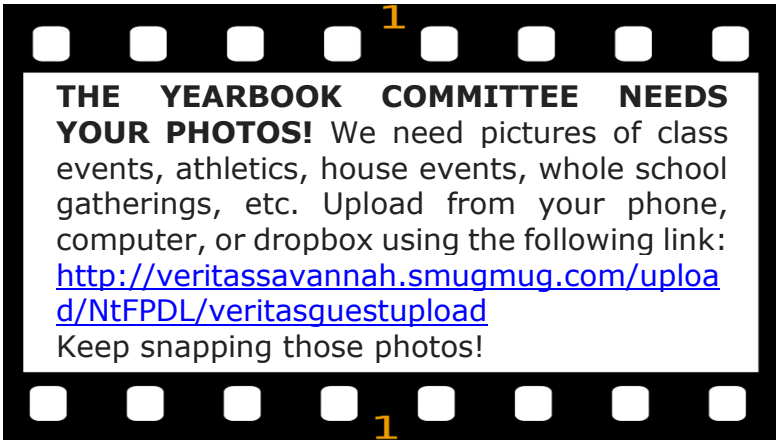
