READ, THINK, & UNDERSTAND ...

Over the past six weeks we have looked at six short statements that describe the essentials of a Veritas education. In this week's Parent E-Mail, you will find links to two articles. One listing the six foundational commitments, in case you may have missed a week or two, and an essay, Ten Pedagogical Essentials of Classical Christian Education. Classical education provides us with not just a curriculum, content, and Trivium framework, but it also gives the pedagogical means and methods to rightly teach the curriculum and content. I went through these with our teachers during teacher orientation in August. They are directed toward classroom teachers, but I believe parents will find them helpful.
