



Five Questions for Future Families

Q 1: Is Your Family Committed To Christ?

The Scriptures say of Jesus Christ, “For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities - all things were created through him and for him. And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together. And he is the head of the body, the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything he might be preeminent. For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross.” (Colossians 1:16-20) We believe that the education of our children begins with these truths. The Scriptures also teach that God has commanded parents to bring up their children in the discipline and instruction of the Lord (Deuteronomy 6:4-9, Ephesians 6:1-4).
