

Veritas Academy Athletic Program

Veritas Academy offers a variety of sports opportunities throughout the school year for enrolled, part-time and homeschooled students 5th -12th grade. Below are the sports that will be offered for the upcoming academic year. Note the season as well as the grades eligible for each sport. Please read the bulleted points to register your child for a sport.

Veritas will require a one-time \$50 non-refundable deposit for sport participation during the 2022-23 academic year due by <u>Friday</u>, <u>July 1</u>. This deposit will be credited to your <u>last</u> <u>athletic fee of the academic year</u>. If your child registers for cross country and track, you will owe the fall athletic fee for cross country in its <u>entirety</u>. When track occurs in the spring, your \$50 deposit will be credited to your spring athletic fee. If your child decides not to participate in a sport he/she has registered for, your \$50 deposit will be forfeited.

<u>Please thoroughly review the practice and game commitments involved with each sport prior to registration.</u>

- To register your child by July 1:
 - Click the link <u>here</u> and fill out all of the necessary information (you will have to complete one for each player in your family)
 - o Pay the \$50 non-refundable deposit here.
- The cost for full time enrolled students is \$85 per student per season. The cost for part-time and homeschooled students is \$170 per student per season and a \$15 processing fee from our athletic leagues. The payment link will be on the Veritas website or you can turn it into the Veritas office.

Payment due dates:

- o August 5 for fall sports
- o October 21 for winter sports
- o February 3 for spring sports

The athletic fee will cover any sport in which your child wishes to participate in the <u>same season</u>. For example, if your child desires to run cross country as well as play flag football in the fall, the fee will cover both.

Veritas must have a completed physical form within the calendar year for each student in order for him/her to participate in any sport.

- Students can take the forms to their personal doctor, Sandfly and Berwick Urgent Cares, or the CVS minute clinics.
- The physical forms are attached <u>here</u> and on the Veritas website. All athletes must complete the first page of the form regarding medical history. The remaining pages are to be completed by the physician.

Co-ed Cross Country

- 5th-12th grade (enrolled or homeschool)
- August 16-October
- Summer conditioning June 9, 16, 23, 30 July 14, 21 at 8am at Daffin Park
- Practice schedule- M, T team practice with Thursday team practice for 8th grade and varsity only at 1:45-3:30, 2 days/wk home running plan
- Practice location is Forsyth Park on team practice days-runners meet at Independent Presbyterian Church (IPC) and return to IPC
- Meet locations and dates TBD

Boys Intramural Flag Football

- 6th-12th grade (enrolled or homeschool boys)
- August 16-October
- Practice schedule- M, TH, F 2-3:30
- Practice location is Forsyth Park (Green Space on Drayton)
- Games are played on Saturday with an occasional Tuesday or Friday- dates and times TBD
- Game location is Pt. Pleasant 441 Suncrest Blvd.

Girls Middle School Volleyball (homeschoolers only eligible for the 7th & 8th grade team)

- 5th-8th grade
- Camp July 11-15
- Season dates: 5th/6th August 8 October; 7th/8th August 1 October
- Practice schedule- M, TU, TH and several F from 2-3:30 or 4pm until games begin
- Practice location Southside Baptist and St. Paul's Lutheran gym
- Games are M, TU, TH, or F averaging 2 per week
- 5th & 6TH game locations are local Savannah schools
- 7th and 8th grade team plays at our home gym and Brunswick, Statesboro, Augusta, Hilton Head, & Bluffton

Girls Junior Varsity Volleyball -tryouts required to sign-up

- 7th grade & up (enrolled students and limited homeschool spots)
- Summer conditioning and camp information will be sent to those invited
- Season dates: August 1-October
- Practice M, T, TH, F from 2p-4p
- Practice location is St. Paul's Lutheran gym 10 W. 31 St.
- Game days TU, TH with occasional M, F, S games averaging 2-3 games per week.
- Game locations include St. Paul's gym, local schools, and travel to Statesboro, Hilton Head, and Augusta

Girls Varsity Volleyball -tryouts required to sign-up

- 8th-12th grade (enrolled students and limited homeschool spots)
- Summer conditioning and camp information will be sent to those invited
- Season dates: August 1-October
- Practice M, T, TH, F from 2p-4p
- Practice location is St. Paul's Lutheran gym 10 W. 31 St.
- Game days TU, TH with occasional M, F, S games averaging 2-3 games per week.
- Game locations include St. Paul's gym, local schools, and travel to Statesboro, Hilton Head, and Augusta

Winter Sports:

Middle School Girls Basketball

- 5th-8th grade for full time enrolled Veritas students
- November- February
- Summer camp June 22-24
- Starting in November practice M, T, TH with occasional F practice
- Practice location is St. Paul's Lutheran gym or Frank Callen Boys and Girls Club
- Games M, T, TH, S averaging 2 per week at local Savannah schools

Middle School Boys Basketball

- 5th-8th grade for full time enrolled Veritas students
- November- February
- Summer camp June 20-22
- Starting in November practice M, T, TH with occasional F practice
- Practice location is St. Paul's Lutheran gym or Frank Callen Boys and Girls Club
- Games M, T, TH, S averaging 2 per week at local Savannah schools

Co-ed Archery

- 5th-12th grade for full time enrolled and homeschool students
- November-March

- Practice 2 days/wk: 5th-7th M, F; 8th-12th TU, TH at 2:15-3:30
- Practice location is Pt. Pleasant located at 441 Suncrest Blvd. on Talahi Island
- Possibly 5 Tournaments (tournament entry is score dependent)
- One tournament will occur in December on a Saturday in Savannah. One will be in Statesboro also on a Saturday, the others are TBD

Co-ed Swimming

- 6th-12th grade for full time enrolled and homeschool students
- November-January
- Practice T, TH & F 2:15-4pm
- Practice location Chatham County Aquatic Center
- 2-4 meets: dates & locations TBD
- In addition to the \$85 athletic fee, there is a swimsuit purchase (if athlete does not own a Veritas team suit).

Spring Sports:

Co-ed Golf (full time enrolled and homeschool students)

- 5th-12th grade instructional class (no athletic fee or deposit required; payment directly to instructor)
- 8th-12th graders are eligible to try out for a Varsity team
- Mid February early May
- Practice 2 days/wk TBD 2-4pm
- Practice location most likely the Westin
- Tournament locations and dates TBD; region and state meet will include 3-4 hour travel

Co-ed Track

- 5th -12th grade (homeschool students are only allowed to compete as a 9-12th grader)
- Mid February- early May
- Practice 2 days/wk TBD
- 2-3 meets for 5th -8th grade
- 3-4 meets for 9th-12th grade; region and state meet will include 3-4 hour travel
- Practice location is Forsyth Park

Veritas will be offering a \$60 family pass or a \$15 student/faculty pass that will pay for admittance into any Veritas **HOME** athletic event for this academic year. These events include varsity, junior varsity, and 7/8 grade volleyball and middle and high school archery tournament. The admission cost at the event will be \$6/adult and \$4/student. The passes will be sold in the school office and home volleyball games.
