Good Morning Veritas Parents,

Greetings! Summer is winding down quickly and it's time to get ready for another great school year. 2023-2024 starts on August 10 -only one more week of summer! The teachers are busy preparing for the arrival of your children. We are all looking forward to seeing your families next week.

- 5. Logic & Rhetoric Parent Orientation, **MANDATORY** (*at least one parent per family*)- Thursday, August 10, 6:30-8:30 pm
- 6. **NO EXTENDED-DAY classes August 10-11**. Extended Day starts Monday, August 14.
- NOON DISMISSAL for ALL students (PreK-12th) on August 10-11 – Staggered dismissal --last names A-M pick up at 12:00, N-Z pick up at 12:10 pm.

Two Links for Your Heart and Mind
